

Laser Hair Reduction Informed Consent

Overview

Please initial after reading each of the following statements:

- _____ Multiple, consecutive treatments are performed until desired level of hair reduction is noticed. 6-12 treatments are required on a specific schedule for optimal results. Required treatments may increase if recommended schedule is not observed.
- _____ The purpose of this treatment is to attempt to reduce unwanted hairs and does not guarantee permanent hair reduction in all cases. There is a slight possibility that the procedure will not cause permanent hair reduction.
- _____ Redness, mild discomfort and minor swelling may occur and usually subsides within 72 hours.
- _____ Color changes such as erythema (redness), hyperpigmentation, or hypopigmentation may occur in treated skin. This may take several months to return to normal.
- _____ Sunscreen must be worn for 4 weeks post treatment to reduce risk of hyper or hypopigmentation.
- _____ Blistering may occur. If this does occur, apply antibiotic ointment until healed. Scarring is rare, but can occur.
- _____ I agree to comply with the pre and post treatment instructions given to me by my professional.

Pre-Treatment Instructions

- Do not tan the area for 30 days prior or apply self tanner 2 weeks prior. You must wear sunscreen daily.
- Do not take the acne medication Accutane 12 months prior to treatment.
- Do not use medications causing photosensitivity for 4 weeks.
- If you have Herpes Simplex, starting an anti-viral medication prior to treatment is recommended to reduce risk of outbreak.
- If you are pregnant or trying to conceive, you may not receive this treatment.
- Shave one day prior to treatment to avoid a trimming charge.
- Do not wax, use a depilatory cream, or tweeze hair 2-4 weeks prior to treatment or for the duration of treatments.

Post-Treatment Instructions

- Redness and minor swelling may persist for 72 hours post treatment.
- Treated hairs may begin to shed 2-3 weeks post treatment.
- Avoid direct sun exposure, excessive heat or hot water to the area for 48 hours.
- In case of blistering, swelling, or discomfort, you may apply hydrocortisone cream and ice the area.
- Although not very common, blistering may also be treated with antibiotic ointment.
- Tanned or darker skin types increase the risk of post inflammatory hyperpigmentation
- You may not tan, even with sunscreen, for 4 weeks post treatment. You must wear sunscreen daily.

Maintenance

Repeating this session 1-2 times per year is recommended to maintain results.

Makeup

Makeup may be worn as soon as you would like. WellQuest Medical & Wellness recommends Glo Minerals.
